## **Talent Show Rules and Regulations**

1. Each act will be allotted three (3) minutes to perform.
2. No profanity or vulgar lyrics in any vocal performance or dance music. Genres of music may include but are not limited to pop, rap, R&B, jazz, country, rock, blues, Latin and gospel.
3. Attire must be respectable and tasteful.
4. No alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertisements are to be shown on any clothing.
5. No pyrotechnics, open flames, sharp objects such as knives or any other dangerous additions.
6. Sound technician and microphone will be provided. Performer must provide their own CD music, instruments, props, keyboard (if preferred over acoustic piano), etc. if needed.
7. Vocalists may use recorded accompaniment tracks with vocal background. Lip singing is not allowed.
8. Acts are not required but encouraged to bring 2 CD's if music will be used in case of malfunctions. Because of quality deviations in CD readers, not all self-made CDs are readable on all machines.
9. Participants must submit their entry form no later than January 16, 2018 to CASA of Bell and Coryell Counties (112 N. Main, Belton, TX 76513) or may be scanned and emailed to ladeal@msn.com. The first 30 in each age category (preschool – elementary; middle school/high school) will be accepted; additional entries will be put on a waiting list.
10. Participants must be available to attend a rehearsal – time TBD – either the evening before (Feb. 23) or the morning of (Feb 24) the talent show. All participants will be informed as to date and time by February 1, 2018.
11. Participants must arrive at the talent show located at the Mary Alice Marshall Performing Arts Center on the Temple College Campus no later than one hour before the performance. Address: 2487-2567 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Temple, TX.
12. Participants must perform acts inside their scope of abilities. Parents knowingly and freely accept risks of injury.
13. Performers will be admitted free of charge. Parents, family, and friends of participants must purchase a ticket to attend the show. Parents, family and friends are also encouraged to purchase a supportive/congratulatory ad to be placed in the talent show program.
